

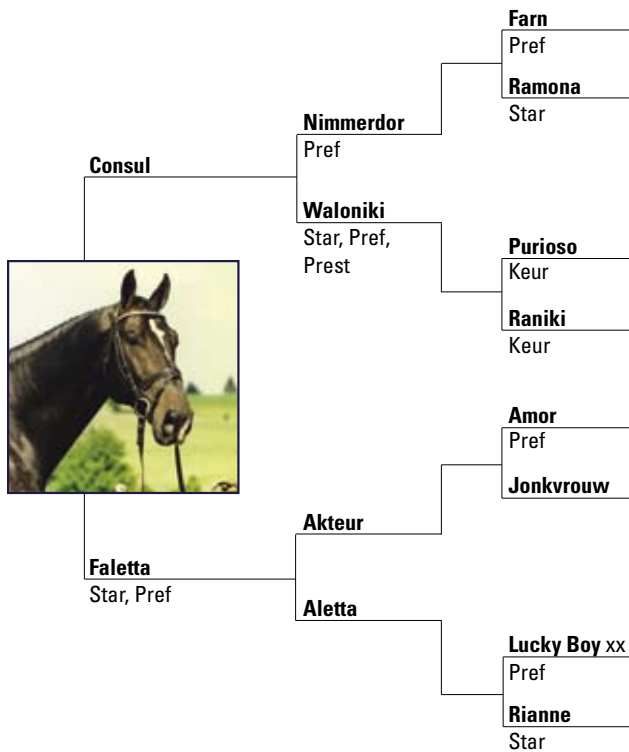

Judgement ISF won nearly \$1,500,000 in his career before he retired sound in 2009. With a performance record that was nearly unmatched, he was not only a fan favorite, but also a reliable partner in all types of show jumping classes. This impressive North American-bred stallion represented the United States internationally in 10 Nations Cup classes, including the gold medal winning team in the Super League competitions at CSIO La Baule in 2006 and Hickstead in 2007. He also represented the U.S. in the 2002 World Equestrian Games.

As an international competitor, Judgement was brave and willing with incredible power and scope. His big heart and excellent character are two of his traits that he is passing on to his sons and daughters. They also inherit his athletic ability and incredible jumping talent.
