What to Expect When You Breed to Kaiman

Kaiman gives really good overall conformation. He is homozygous black and does not carry the red factor gene. Kaiman will not produce chestnut offspring and has the potential to sire black offspring.

Offspring Characteristics

- Friendly, inquisitive dispositions
- Trainable with talent for dressage
- Very long, correct and elastic walk
- Powerful, supple trot with lots of reach and balance
- Canter with normal reach and elasticity, add power
- Body conformation: slightly square
- Uphill build
- Light head neck connection
- Normal length of neck, vertical necks with good muscling
- Well-developed withers
- More sloping shoulder
- Strong back & loins
- Croup is sloping and short
- Front legs normal
- Hind legs– can be slightly straight
- Pasterns- can be slightly weak
- Feet-slightly narrow
- Heels tend to be slightly high
- Nice, lean legs
- Lighter, modern type bone
- Height–normal height
