Offspring Characteristics

- Rectangular type
- Long neck with nice muscling, set on slightly vertical
- High withers with good position
- Sloping shoulder with good length
- Good back
- Excellent croup with good length and angle
- Very good pasterns with good length and angle
- Excellent wide feet
- Very good quality legs with good bone
- Long and elastic walk stride
- Trot, elastic with power and carrying ability
- Excellent canter with good length of stride

Ideal Pairing

Consul is not recommended for mares with:

- Heavy head/neck connection
- Weak loin area
- Low heels
- Front legs back at the knee
- Straight hind leg
- Not much suspension to the trot
