- Beautiful necks
- Well-developed withers
- Correct legs
- Three supple, quality gaits
- Balance and adjustability
- Ability to extend and collect
- Friendly with outstanding temperaments
- Trainable, rideable, and good work ethic
- Good jumping ability

Ideal Pairing

- Uphill, long-lined mares
- Mares with good rectangular shape
- Not recommended for mares with downhill conformation; square, compact shape; deep back; or narrow feet
