Teade's offspring inherit his jet-black color, beautiful coat, and abundant, thick, long hair. He passes on pretty heads and good conformation. Teade is known for his charismatic and trainable personality—traits he passes on to his sons and daughters. He throws a powerful, balanced canter, with good carrying power and produces a good Friesian type.

Offspring Characteristics

- Great temperaments, kind, easygoing
- Very trainable
- Beautiful, noble heads
- Uphill build
- Necks are slightly horizontal and sometimes have a heavy head/neck connection
- Straight shoulder
- Good loin connection
- Good length in hamstrings and front legs
- Shortens the back
- Very correct pasterns, sometimes short
- Improves leg conformation
- Adds some length to the front leg
- Powerful walk with good reach
- Average trot
- Very balanced, powerful canter
- Jet black coats
- Thick hair
- Adds a little height

Ideal Pairing

Teade is not recommended for mares with:

- Short backs
- Sloped croup
- Over at the knee
- Sickie hocks
- Toed-out walk
- Small size
